



EuroPeers UK is a network for young people aged 16-30, who have studied, volunteered or taken part in educational projects in other countries. Join us, support us or invite us to your school, college or group, to share our personal experiences and help you find your own life-changing international opportunities.

- EuroPeers are young people who have travelled to other countries to study, get work experience, or take part in education or youth projects funded by Erasmus Plus and the European Solidarity Corps.
- EuroPeers UK was launched in 2016 and is managed by Momentum World CIC. The network has presence all across the UK with regional hubs led by the young people.
- EuroPeers UK membership is open to anyone aged 16-30 with international experience or interests.
- By telling their own stories EuroPeers inform, motivate and support other young people to get involved in life-changing international projects with Erasmus+ and the ESC.
- EuroPeers organise local activities at universities, youth clubs, schools and they can be invited for activities and fairs.
- EuroPeers lead national and international training courses for young people who want to become EuroPeers.
- EuroPeers release a monthly newsletter with upcoming opportunities- you can sign up via our website.
- EuroPeers give personal mobility counselling to young people before and during their international activity.
- EuroPeers work with other organisations and groups to help them promote their activities and get information out to young people.
